ABOUT THE ROLE

As Flight Operations and Test, you will play a crucial role in the safe and efficient operation of our unmanned aircraft. Your responsibilities will include providing ground crew support for all flight operations and flight test events, working closely with the Senior Test Pilot as a required crew member. In addition to these responsibilities, you will also be responsible for maintaining the airworthiness of on-site aircraft by performing regular inspections and repairs as needed.

Additional responsibilities include ground and bench testing aircraft components, and assisting engineers with quality control. Throughout development of our aircraft and systems, you will work with engineering to provide valuable feedback on design and end user experience, as well as contribute to the build itself.

To succeed in this role, you will need to have strong attention to detail and excellent communication skills, as well as the ability to work independently and in a team environment. You should also have a strong understanding of aviation regulations, safety standards, and fielded flight and ground testing activities. You should be able to effectively troubleshoot and problem-solve in a fast-paced operational environment.

Overall you will play a key role in ensuring the safe and efficient operation of our unmanned aircraft, and will have the opportunity to contribute to the ongoing development and improvement of our products and services.



WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Required ground crew member for flight operations
- Troubleshoot technical problems with aircraft and ground support equipment and systems
- Work with engineering teams to improve and develop aircraft systems and support equipment
- Lab, bench and ground test aircraft components and subsystems
- Provide the Senior Test Pilot with procedural, technical and documentation feedback and recommendations
- Develop maintenance procedures, ground crew operational documentation, checklists and training
- Provide maintenance as needed to ensure a FMC (Fully Mission Capable) test site, ground support equipment and aircraft.
- Log crew proficiency and training as needed
- Review flight and maintenance logs for accuracy as required for flight events
- Transport aircraft, personnel and equipment to and from test site locations
- Set up of test site and ground support equipment
- Implement Test Site needs or improvements
- Work with the Senior Test Pilot and Airport Management to communicate flight scheduling and operational requirements and restrictions
